In order to vote and have one's vote counted at this meeting, a Democratic State Central Committee (DSCC) member must be fully credentialed by having timely (1) paid or waived (requested in writing by the delegate) both their 2025 DSCC Dues and 2025 State Convention Registration fees and (2) obtained their credential prior to the close of credentialing if they were issued. Once registered the member must (3) complete and return to the proper authority any ballot that may be issued and (4) agreed in writing to abide by the [Code of Conduct](#).
